Regular Meeting Minutes

November 20, 2017

Mayor Shebetka called the regular meeting of the Springville City Council to order at 6:00 pm at City Hall. Present on roll call: Councilpersons: Dennis Thies, Brad Merritt, Pat Hoyt, and Mareta Ralston. Also in attendance were: Lyle Andersen, Treva Davis, Bob Tobin, Jean Menster, Tyson Jacobi, Jean Schmidt, Gordon Trampe, and Steve Knopse.

Lyle Andersen was sworn in as Council Person to complete Penny Sindelar's term.

A discussion was held on potential of Dollar General opening a store on Old Dubuque Road near Wendling Quarry. Bob Tobin presented a preliminary plan for bring city water to the location. The council took no action as it was deemed too early in the process to take action at this time.

A presentation by Bob Tobin and discussion was held on the status of easements for the 5th Street Project. It is estimated there will be about two more weeks before legal descriptions are available.

A discussion was held on Fireworks within the city limits but no action was taken at this time.

A special meeting will be scheduled with Brown Township on our mutual 28E Fire Agreement tentatively on January 8th, 2018.

Treva Davis reported that research on banner pricing continues.

Action on old utility account debt was postponed until the December 4th 2018 meeting.
