

The pledge of allegiance was recited to begin the meeting.

The Springville City Council met in a special session in the Springville Council Chambers on July 16, 2018.

Mayor Shebetka called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Dennis Thies, Brad Merritt, Jeff Grimley, Lyle Andersen, and Mareta Ralston. City Staff present: Interim City Clerk Dee Wagaman. Guests: Chris Williams, Thomas Anthony of Shoemaker & Haaland, Mark Parmenter the City attorney and Treva Davis.

Ralston made a motion to approve the agenda, second from Andersen. Motion carried.

Mayor Shebetka invited Citizens with input to speak. No input.

Tom Anthony from Shoemaker & Haaland presented the annexation and the easements. He showed the boundaries of the proposed annexed property owned by Wendling Quarries. Andersen made a motion to set public hearing regarding Wendling Quarry Easements at July 23, 2018 meeting, second from Grimley. Motion carried.

Mayor Shebetka presented letters that will need to go out to other area fire departments to request their services on August 10th and 11th, 2018 due to the Springville Fire Department being unable to be there. Chris Williams verified that Anamosa Area Ambulance is providing the EMS services. Thies made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute letters on behalf of the City to engage Fire Department services and EMS services for the Springville Tractor Puller's Association event, second from Andersen.

Discussion was held on the parking situation on 1st Ave. The Springville Council is concerned with people parking on the travel portion of 1st Ave. This topic will be brought up on the next meeting for letters to be possibly be sent out. They have requested that Wyman, Public Works Supervisor research the cost of signage and how many signs it might take.

There being no further discussion, Andersen moved to adjourn at 6:50 p.m., second from Thies. Motion carried.
