

The Springville City Council met in a joint meeting with the Springville Community School Board in the Board Room of the Springville High School on November 12, 2018. Mayor Shebetka called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Brad Merritt, Dennis Thies, Lyle Andersen, and Mareta Ralston. Jeff Grimley was absent. City Staff present: City Clerk/Treasurer Dee Wagaman. School Board present: Todd Nulle, Albert Martin, Superintendent, Pat Hocking and board secretary Stacey Matus.

Thies made a motion to approve the agenda as written, second from Andersen. Motion carried.

Mayor Shebetka invited Citizens with input to speak. There being no comments from citizens, Mayor Shebetka moved to business.

Mayor Shebetka started the meeting by discussing the pedestrian crossing lights that are planned to go on 5th Street. He would like to see if the school has some resources to help with this part of the project. Shebetka updated the board on the Sanitary Sewer project.

Superintendent Pat Hocking thanked all the vets and updated the council on the school projects. The sidewalk in front of the new elementary is being evaluated at this time. Enrollment is steady and the school will see its new money next year from the large enrollment hike last year. The gym floor in Machovec gymnasium will be completely replaced this summer. They are also putting up more signage and some outdoor security cameras. He also wanted to thank Todd Wyman for all his work with the street project and the communication with the school.

Andersen made a suggestion to maybe get some signs up on JR Barnes Parkway to remind the football traffic to slow down.

The next regular council meeting will be November 19, 2018 at 6:00 P.M. at city hall.

There being no further discussion, Andersen moved to adjourn at 6:50 P.M., second from Ralston. Motion carried.
