What we're doing to keep you safe:

- We have removed all soft toys and as many fabric items as possible from the area.
- We are wiping down counters, keyboards, tables, DVD cases, and as many books as we can, as frequently as possible.
- We have hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes available at the circulation desk.
- The sinks in the bathrooms, and the kitchen have been stocked with hand soap.
- We have cancelled our programs indefinitely.

What you can do to help:

- Know the signs and symptoms, and stay home if you show any.
- Patrons under 16 will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer. Cover your mouth when sneezing or coughing, and wash your hands after.
- Limit close contact with other patrons. Try to avoid touching your face.
- Please consider sanitizing items before returning, and remember our outside drop box.
- Check the library website or Facebook for any updates on the situation. Before visiting, call ahead to make sure we're open.
