

**NOTICE
CITY OF SPRINGVILLE, IOWA**

The City of Springville is required to update its floodplain management ordinance to adopt and reference the new floodplain maps that become effective on July 20, 2021. FEMA is requiring the city to reference the new maps within its floodplain ordinance to remain in good standing with the National Flood Insurance Program. In addition to adopting the new maps the city is also adopting new regulations for Accessory Structure and Maximum Damage Potential Development. The ordinance includes a penalty for violations in section 160.09 as follows:

160.09 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION. Violations of the provisions of this Ordinance or failure to comply with any of the requirements (including violations of conditions and safeguards established in connection with grants of Variances) shall constitute a misdemeanor. Any person who violates this Ordinance or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than \$500.00 (five hundred dollars) or imprisoned for not more than 30 (thirty) days. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained prevent the City of Springville from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy violation.

Ordinance 19-2021 – Flood Plain Management was approved by the city council on May 17, 2021 and will be effective upon publication of this notice.
