



WERE YOU IMPACTED BY THE STORM?

Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) is available for Linn County residents who were impacted by the derecho and subsequent power outages on August 10, 2020. Eligible families will receive D-SNAP in an amount equal to one month of the maximum amount of Food Assistance/SNAP benefits, based on household size. **Applicants must apply in person August 31 - September 6, 2020 at one of the sites listed below.**

WHO MAY BE ELIGIBLE

- ▶ Residents of Linn County as of August 10th
- ▶ Those who meet the income limits
- ▶ Those who have been adversely affected by the derecho including destroyed/spoiled food

CURRENT FOOD ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS

Current Food Assistance recipients in Linn County are not eligible to receive D-SNAP benefits as they will already receive the maximum allotment of Food Assistance benefits for their household size in August and September.

ELIGIBLE PURCHASES

Some eligible food items include dairy products, eggs, meat, cereal, rice, pasta, bread, fresh, frozen canned or dried vegetables and fruit, any ingredients you use for cooking, baby formula, diabetic foods, garden seeds, plants for growing food at home, and ice. Hot foods and hot food products are eligible to be purchased from participating retailers with D-SNAP benefits through September 21, 2020.

WHERE TO APPLY

Cedar Rapids

- ▶ Ladd Library: 3750 Williams Boulevard SW
D-SNAP operations at Ladd Library will be held outside in the parking lot.
- ▶ U.S. Cellular Center: 370 First Avenue NE

Marion

- ▶ Marion Square Shopping Center:
1107 Seventh Avenue

Due to COVID-19 precautions, DHS workers will complete applications onsite during the interview with applicants. To review the application prior to applying onsite for D-SNAP, persons can visit the DHS website. All applications will be provided in Creole, English, French, Kirundi, Spanish, and Swahili.

SITE GUIDELINES

- ▶ We encourage you to wear a face mask. Sites will implement COVID-19 precautions.
- ▶ Applicants need to provide proof of identification and are encouraged to bring something showing their address in Linn County.
- ▶ 9-10 a.m. will be reserved for the elderly and individuals with disabilities.
- ▶ Arrive no sooner than 8 a.m.
- ▶ Application processing will end at 7 p.m. Applicants who are still on site at that time will be given priority the next day.
- ▶ Translation services are available at each site.
